

THE GRIFFITH DEVELOPMENTAL SCALE

Age In Months	Personal - Social
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Regards person – momentarily. • Quieted when picked up. • Enjoys bath.
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smiling. • Visually recognizes mother.
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vocalizes when talked to. • Follows moving persons with eyes. • Returns examiner's glance with smiling or cooing.
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Friendly to strangers. • Resists adult who tries playfully to take toy. • Frolics when played with.
5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stops crying when talked to. • Turns head to person talking or singing.
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Anticipatory movements when about to be lifted. • Holds a spoon. • Stretches to be taken.
7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drinks from a cup. • Manipulates cup or spoon in play.
8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reacts to mirror image (I): Looks at. • Knows strangers from familiar friends. • Prompt reaction to situation, e.g. at table.
9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Displeased if toy is taken away. • Helps to hold cup for drinking. • Pulls off hat.
10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reacts to mirror image (II): Smiles at, or plays with. • Waves bye-bye.
11	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gives affection. • Finger feeds (thumb and forefinger).
12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plays with cup, spoon, and saucer. • Obeys simple requests: "Please give me the cup" etc. • Plays "Pat-a-cake" (claps hands).
13	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Puts small objects in and out of cup in play. • Tries to help with dressing, slides arms into coat and so forth.
14	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can hold cup for drinking. • Uses spoon and spills some.
15	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shows shoes. • Tries to turn doorknob.
16	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Asks to be clean
17	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Manages cup well half full. • Can take off shoes to show socks.
18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Likes adult to show book.
19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parts of body (1). • Bowel control completed.
20	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Uses spoon well. • Bladder control by day.
21	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tries to tell experiences.
22	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Asks for things at table by name. • Parts of body (2).
23	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parts of body (3). • Parts of body (4)+.

24	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can open a door.• Helps actively to dress or undress.
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
